

## PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIP INVESTMENT



The Association has created a scholarship platform to invest within its members. Each year, based upon funding, IPRA will empower its professional members through national training, in-state training, and professional development experiences.

Beginning in autumn 2018, \$2,250 will be awarded to advance the profession. Recipients will be announced during 2019 Conference luncheon.

In a nutshell, here's the opportunity to grow one's self, agency, community, and profession.

### **The Kathryn Krieg and IPRA *Invest in You* Membership Scholarship (National Training)**

Available to IPRA members in good standing after completing at least three years of full time equivalent service in the Parks and Recreation profession within the state of Iowa. Scholarship must be used to cover the direct expenses up to \$1,000 of attending a national professional development opportunity in the field of Parks and Recreation.

Criteria used to determine eligibility include but not limited to:

- Explanation of financial assistance
- Professional Development attendance history
- Demonstration of applicability to Parks and Recreation professional development
- Funding must be used within 24 months of award

### **The Kathryn Krieg and IPRA *Invest in You* Membership Scholarship (In-State Training)**

Available to IPRA members in good standing after completing at least one year of full time equivalent service in the Parks and Recreation profession within the state of Iowa. Scholarship must be used to cover the direct expenses up to \$500 of attending a state professional development opportunity in the field of Parks and Recreation.

Criteria used to determine eligibility include but not limited to:

- Explanation of financial assistance
- Professional Development attendance history
- Demonstration of applicability to Parks and Recreation professional development
- Funding must be used within 24 months of award

### **Musco/Outdoor Recreation Products Professional Development Scholarship**

Up to \$750 scholarship available to IPRA members in good standing who are a practitioner in pursuance of undergraduate/graduate study or professional certification in the field of parks and recreation. This scholarship will be offered so long as the giver(s) wish to continue this opportunity.
