## PRINCIPAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Irrigation of all fields and grounds, and maintenance of all under ground irrigation systems.
- Maintains all field preparations including marking, dragging, raking, chalking, painting, and moving of goals.
- Performs manual labor as directed including painting, digging, caulking, cleaning, mowing, hauling, and loading.
- Landscapes as directed, including mulching and pruning trees, planting and transplanting trees, flowers and shrubs, seeding, laying sod, fertilizing and watering.
- Applies chemical applications, pesticides and insecticides, as needed, to ensure weed control and general upkeep.
- Performs snow removal on the sports complex grounds and from city parking lots and sidewalks.
- Makes regular rounds to inspect conditions, pick up trash, and remove debris from the sports complex grounds.
- Makes minor repairs to buildings and equipment and assist in basic construction work as needed.
- Cleans and maintains division vehicles, equipment, and tools.
- Attends training and safety courses as needed.
