The City of Ely is searching for a talented and energetic Summer Intern to join our Parks & Recreation Department for the 2023 season. The Recreation Intern will be responsible for overseeing the youth programs throughout the spring, summer, and early fall months, which include but are not limited to soccer, baseball, introduction to sports and summer camp. The Intern will assist in the planning and implementation of special events including the Summer Camp Out, Ely Open and Fall Fest. They will also be responsible for overseeing concession stand operations. Schedule: 20-40-hour work weeks depending on the month. Must be available to work a varied schedule including mornings, evenings, and occasional weekends. \$11-\$13/hr based on qualifications and experience. Background check required. EOE. Start date May 1, 2023 (flexible).

Responsibilities:

- Provide overall assistance to the Director of Parks & Recreation
- Work closely with the Recreational Assistant
- Oversee and/or lead recreation programs
- Assist in planning and implementation of special events
- Manage concession stand during baseball season and special events
- Develop 3-5 new programs that are "turn-key" and ready for implementation
- Attend monthly Park Board meetings
- Other duties as required or assigned

- Strong communication skills
- Comfortable working with different populations
- Ability to multitask, problem solve and be self-motivated

- CPR and First Aid certification preferred

- Standing, stooping and bending for long periods of time
- Must be willing to work a flexible schedule to includes mornings, evenings and occasional weekends
