

The Iowa Sports Foundation (ISF) has an opening for a full-time Director of Sports and Competitions. The Director, reporting to the Chief Operating Officer, oversees the operations of the Iowa Games, Iowa Senior Games, and Adaptive Sports Iowa. This position directly leads the planning and execution of the Summer Iowa Games, one of the largest state-wide, multi-sport Olympic-style festivals in the nation. This is a leadership role within the Foundation and currently manages two full-time staff members.

The lowa Sports Foundation offers a wide range of benefits, including a hybrid, flexible work environment. While there are no residency requirements, employees must be able to be on-site in Ames on a regular basis, including daily during peak event season.

- Recognize and pursue new sport and event opportunities statewide

- Serve as a member of the ISF Leadership Team
- Manage effective public relations and promotion of events, including assisting in developing marketing plans
- Coordinating volunteer recruitment and assignments
- Update website content & online registration
- Assist in assigning and directing interns and work-study students

- Serve as liaison to the National Congress of State Games, including duties for NCSG national office as assigned
- Assist with other Iowa Sports Foundation programs, events, and challenges
