Project Overview

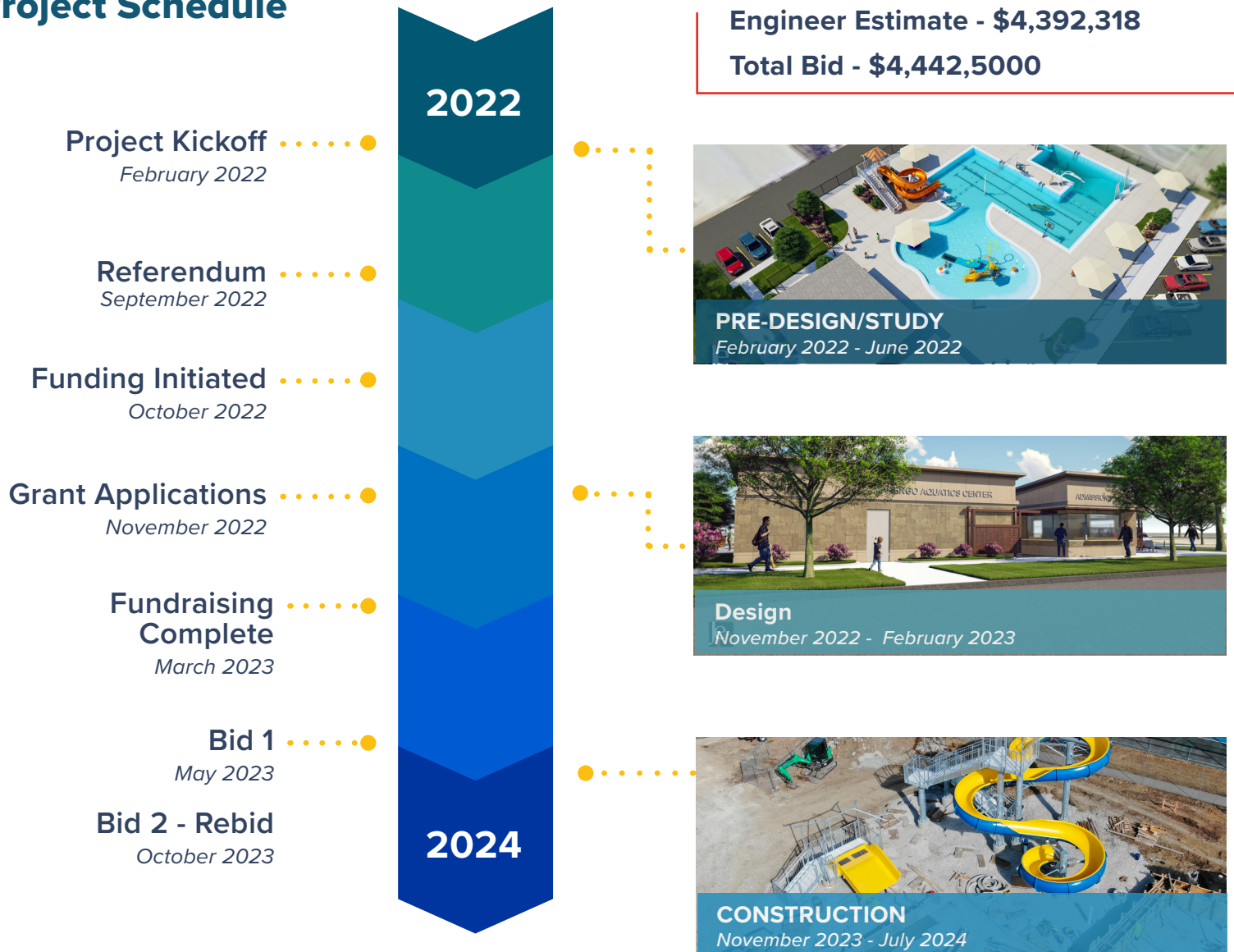


About the Project

The City of Marengo has enjoyed its public pool since 1975. Over the years, various repairs have been made to the pool, and the public has donated money to keep the facility operating. The summer of 2019 was the last season the facility was open, and significant repairs are required to reopen.

In the fall of 2021, the city hired JEO Consulting Group to address the existing pool and guide a pool committee comprised of citizens, city staff, and city council members to develop a concept plan for the future of the public pool. After reviewing several alternatives and discussing multiple features, the committee selected the illustrated concept shown above and below. In September 2022, the primary funding was secured through a referendum vote that allowed the city to issue \$3.8 million in bonds.
