



****Registrants will receive final details for the conference prior to the event. This is where you will find all the information you will need to ensure your conference experience goes as smoothly as possible. Please read all details thoroughly. You will also receive a survey you must respond to in order to indicate your attendance at conference events. For Tuesday evening, you MUST indicate you are attending on this survey to receive a ticket.**

Q: What should I wear while attending the conference and conference events?

A: Educational Sessions/Day Time Activities: Dress as if you were headed to work for the day! Bring layers as some areas may be chilly!
Evening Socials: Casual attire
